### RUBBISH!

Fly-tippers have been busy polluting the West End of Leicester with piles of rubbish strewn across the Fosse and Westcotes wards.

This is not a new problem, but it appears to be getting worse, with Braunstone Gate and Western Road becoming regular targets.

The front page picture features a pile of veg boxes left on Braunstone Gate. City Wardens are searching for CCTV footage which will help identify the fly-tippers.



It's not just residents inconsiderately chucking out domestic waste - some of the fly-tips across the West End are huge and have included bathtubs full of building waste, furniture and household appliances.

City Wardens have been issuing legal notices to residents who have thrown their household waste onto the street, including businesses, like a bar and restaurant on Narborough Road, who were continually dumping rubbish and allowing their waste bins to overflow onto the pavement.

Wardens have been door knocking to hand deliver educational leaflets and orange bags to homes who have side waste and are not recycling.

Last year, fly tipping cost Leicester City Council £374,000 to clean up nearly 10,000 incidents despite clawing back some of the cost through fines.

The average fine for the cost of cleansing services to remove a fly-tip is £400 - a drop in an ocean of rubbish.

### **KNOTT'S LANDING**

September is back to school month and it occurs to me that we really need to start valuing our teachers.

After explaining 'fronted adverbial' and 'past continuous' to a friend and watching them having a mild seizure trying to work it out, I have nothing but respect for those trying to get that into the minds of Roblox and Minecraft obsessed children.

I recently heard someone moaning about teachers and how they don't work hard and the old chestnut about six weeks off in the summer came up. Well, here's a little nugget for you – teachers don't get paid for those six weeks off. They only get paid for the 190 days your little munchkin is in school plus a bit of what, I think, is called directed time – the time their headteacher can tell them what to do. Their salary is spread out over 12 months so they don't go broke on gin and books over the summer.

I get some people didn't have a good time at school, but I don't have great memories of the dentist — I don't go around slagging them off as workshy because they have holidays. Teachers do a tough job looking after the nation's children. WWCE's Project Hive is run by local residents who are fundraising to redevelop the Eco House on Western Park into a community space.

We are delighted to announce that the road to a new community space in Western Park for everyone has reached its most significant milestone yet, our plans have been approved!

WWCE have been working tirelessly since 2016 to secure the ongoing use of part of the land for community use. Following a successful crowdfunding campaign in late 2019, we engaged GSS Architecture to draw up our ambitious plans to redevelop the site from its present derelict state.

The former "Eco House" was a symbol of Leicester's status as the UK's first Environment City. Both WWCE and GSS carefully considered the history of the site in order to respect the environmental ethos of the house, by the creation of a sustainable, eco-friendly, and bio-diverse development at the heart of the community, dubbed Project Hive.

In addition to the variety of community spaces that will be available within Project Hive, there will also be both indoor and outdoor teaching areas, available for use by local schools.

The hard work to find £500K for construction now begins with the hope that links to local businesses and educational facilities can be forged to move the project forward.



And talking of fundraising - it's almost time for this year's Western Park Scarecrow Trail! The theme is "The World Of Books", so look out for some of your favourite literary characters popping up on our local streets! There will be two locations, on either side of Hinckley Road, where you can buy a guide map. Details of the sites will be available on our website and Facebook page. There will also be other craft stalls located along the route and marked on the map. All of the officially numbered scarecrows will be competing for the title of "Best Scarecrow" voted for by those who come along and walk the trail.

We hope to see lots of you out and about on the weekend of the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> on September, starting at 10am!

#### Leicester in The Renaissance

It's no secret that Leicester is a city rich with history, and we're fortunate in that we have an exciting range of museums and historical sites right on our doorstep. One period which particularly fascinates me is the Renaissance, and if it's one that you or your children are interested in too there's plenty of places you can visit to get a taste for its vibrant – and sometimes gory! - history.

If your children are studying Shakespeare in school this year, it's well worth paying a visit to Leicester's Guildhall. Shakespeare wasn't always a playwright - in fact, he started his dramatic career as an actor, and it's rumoured that he performed at the Guildhall with his travelling theatre troupe in the late 16th century. It's also the site at which a thanksgiving dinner was held for Cromwell's troops after they defeated the Royalists at the Battle of Naseby in the 1640s.

In Abbey Park, you'll find the statue of Cardinal Wolsey just by the ruins of the former abbey. Wolsey was once one of Henry VIII's most treasured advisors, but after a falling out over his failure to procure an annulment for the King's marriage to Catherine of Aragon, he quickly fell out of favour. In 1530, Wolsey was summoned back to London on a charge of treason, but fell ill and died in Leicester Abbey on his way. Supposedly, his mortal remains lie somewhere in the grounds of the

park, although after several attempts at excavation they are yet to be found.

If you're feeling particularly adventurous, you might want to make the trip to Bradgate Park. where you'll find the ruins of Bradgate House the birthplace of Lady Jane Grey. Often referred to as the 'Nine Days' Queen', Lady Jane Grey was crowned Queen of England on the 10<sup>th</sup> of July 1554. Just nine days later, however, Henry VIII's daughter Mary made a challenge for the throne, and Lady Jane Grey was beheaded. She was aged only 16 or 17 and it is reported that she had some difficulty finding the chopping block once blindfolded. Gruesome stuff! Alexandra Tunstall

### Brew Can Do It!

The West End Brewery and Tap Room on Braunstone Gate raised the bar with a crowdfunding project after a major disaster saw £8000 flushed down the drain.

Owner and brewer Josh Gray said: "We decided to create our own collection of canned beers, so that anyone, no matter where they live, could enjoy a taste of the WEB. We rolled up our beer-brewing sleeves, sprang into action and paid a substantial amount to a canning machine supplier who suddenly went bust, taking all our hard-earned money with them."

Not one to cry in his beer, Josh found a new canning machine supplier but needed to recover £8K. So, the plan to start a Crowdfunder was hatched. What he wasn't expecting was the speed at which the initial £6K target would be met. He said: "We hit our main target after just three days - which is way beyond what we expected."

The crowdfunding goal has now been stretched to £10K as Josh explains: "Our initial target helped get back much of the



money we lost. Now we hope to be able to continue our efforts so we can recover the rest and help redevelop our website to help sell our new canned craft beer range to beer lovers across the country. "Thanks for everyone's support so far. It really means so much to us."

The Crowdfunder runs to the end of August and offers a number of beer related tiers from £10 to £1000 including corporate sponsorship.

### Picturing Lockdown

action, by carrying two digital cameras, and began photographing the silent, empty streets, and this went on almost daily for months to come."

### **Aug Police Update**

A woman has died following a night-time collision near Hinckley Road/New Parks Way roundabout involving a black VW Golf R and a blue Nissan Micra, on 3 July.

The 23-year-old was taken to the Queen's Medical Centre, Nottingham for treatment but sadly died from her injuries.

Three men were arrested but detectives from the Serious Collision Investigation Unit would still like to speak to anyone with information who has not yet come forward. Quote ref 748 of 3 July.

Police are appealing for information after an incident in New Parks that left three men with serious injuries.

Around 11pm on Wednesday 21 July, officers received a report of an injured man on Ryder Road, and along with the East Midlands Ambulance Service attended the scene. Three men were taken to the LRI with serious injuries.

A 42-year-old local man was arrested on suspicion of causing grievous bodily harm and remains in custody.

DS Nick Woodrow said: "We believe two men were riding quad bikes in the area and ask anyone who may have seen them or captured them on dash cam to please get in touch on 101 quoting reference 21\*40921."

Detectives are investigating an incident where a man was assaulted, on Pindar Road in New Parks, by a group of people shortly before 6pm on Sunday 1 August.

A man in his 30s was approached by four men who got out of a black Mercedes. He was hit with what he believed to be a pole and the group then left the scene in the car. DS Nick Woodrow: "Any information you have, whether you were an eyewitness or have footage from a dashcam or doorbell, could help our investigation." Quote Ref 21\*431104.

Six warrants have been executed at properties across the county including addresses at Gallards Hill in Braunstone and Prince Albert Drive in Glenfield. This follows an investigation into car insurance fraud involving classic cars, which resulted from the execution of a Misuse of Drugs Act warrant in Coalville.

A fully-restored blue Ford Granada was recovered, along with a large amount of cash and number plates connected to other insurance fraud. Five men have been released under investigation.

DC Natasha Perkins said: "We still have outstanding vehicles we are trying to locate and we're asking anyone with any information that might help us find them to please get in touch." The missing cars are a blue Ford MK1 Granada XL, a 1960 Rover P5, possibly in grey, and a blue 1976 Ford Granada Ghia.

# CAREY'S COMPOST SECONDER

The next few weeks are a very busy time in the garden! I'm making sure I water my evergreen shrubs on a regular basis, especially azaleas and camellias, as it's now that their flower buds are developing for flowering next year. I'm also constantly deadheading flowering annuals and perennials to encourage further flowering rather than letting them go to seed. Additionally, I'm cutting back my herbs in the herb bed to encourage another flush of leaves before the frosts get them. I'm freezing any excess leaves that I've accumulated so I can have access to tasty herbs all year round.

If you have any lavender plants that have flowered, you should trim them back to keep them nice and compact. In addition, trim fading perennials, this keeps the garden looking fresh and well-tended. I've also been collecting seed heads as I'd like to establish a wildflower/meadow area, this will be fantastic for wildlife and

pollinating insects if successful! In the vegetable garden, keep feeding crops such as tomatoes and peppers.

I've also pinched out the tops and side shoots of my tomatoes, so all nourishment is concentrated on the growing fruits. Further to this, it's good to pinch out the tops of runner beans to encourage side shooting and therefore a bigger crop.



My main crop of potatoes should also be ready to harvest soon - if there is a glut of these, I'll store them in hessian sacks which allow ventilation but exclude light, which is the perfect environment for storage.

I've been taking lots of pictures of my garden throughout the seasons so I can see where I need to remove plants, for instance if they're not the right height or where I can put new plants in. Keeping a photographic record also helps when ordering your spring bulbs. Now is a great time to do this so they arrive in good time for planting out. As always, please keep bird and bee baths full and check if your pond needs filling because even if we've had rain, a little bit of sun or wind can evaporate the existing water!


