

KING RICHARD RIDES AGAIN

As the Foxes took on Chelsea in the FA Cup Final, local artist, Mono, was putting the final flourishes to a large mural on the wall of Bazaar Mart on Glenfield Road. The mural was commissioned through Graffwerk Arts Projects in collaboration with Leicester City Council. Graffwerk's Izzy Hopkins said: "LCC approached us to create a mural depicting a battle scene during the time of King Richard the Third's reign.

"We decided that it would be great to work with local artist MONO as his style was a great fit for the project. Following consultation and a number of drawings, the final design was selected and it was agreed to complete the work."

The mural was originally due to be started in the spring of 2020 but things did not go to plan as Emily Johnson from Bazaar Mart explains: "Trevor Mee, the council's development manager, came in just before lockdown with a plan to regenerate the area with a mural. He showed us a few drawings and we chose one; didn't think it'd come off; then Boom, it did. Then, covid hit and put it back a long way but we had to have the wall rendered as well."

Both Emily and her dad, Jim, are impressed with the results: "It's phenomenal, really good. Better than we could ever have imagined."

Leicester born Lee Drummond, better known as

Mono, is the talent behind much of the city's street art including the Leicester City mural near the Magazine. This current project has been occupying him and his spray cans for over a month. He said: "The council approached me wanting a Battle of Bosworth mural for this area. We went through a design process and whittled it down to this one - then it gets delayed for a year."

Creating the mural is an intricate and time-consuming job. "First of all, we have to plot it all out and get it in proportion, I get on the scaffold tower and mark it all out, as accurately as I can and then start working into it with colour. There's been a some delay, down to the rain, but it's done now!"



The Festival of Leicestershire and Rutland Archaeology will be running from July 3rd to August 1st. The county festival is part of the UK's national Festival of Archaeology.



STAINED GLASS GENIUS

Theodora Salusbury is not a name that readily comes to mind I guess. But in the world of Stained Glass Art, she is known as one of the most prolific and talented artists of this genre, and of her generation. Many fine examples of her work can still be found locally, casting their colourful, sunlit intricate patterns over historic church interiors.

She was born in Leicester on May 24, 1875. For many years Theodora and her family lived in Lianwern Lodge, next to St. James The Greater on London Road, where her father (Llewelyn), was appointed a warden to the church which was newly built at the time. He faithfully carried out his duties from 1894 to 1901.

At the age of 19 in 1894, Theodora was attending the old Leicester School of Art where she excelled at drawing and obtained a first class grade. From here she went to The Royal College of Art. Other studies followed, and eventually she found her path into designing stained glass windows, taking on commissions throughout England, many of which are in and around Leicester and Leicestershire.

She was actively involved in the creation of her windows - choosing the coloured glass and either cutting it herself or supervising the work and then painting it. Look carefully and you'll see many of her windows are signed by her artist's mark, a peacock in full plumage.



The above image is 'The World War One Memorial' at All Saints Church in Newtown Longford, and it was one of two commissions from Theodora by the Everards family. Other windows can be found at churches in Charnwood, Narborough, Queniborough, Kimcote, Birstall, Scraftoft, as well as several church's in the city.

Her final years were spent first in St Agnes Cornwall where she had a studio, finally settling in the city of Bath, sharing a house with her sisters. Theodora Salusbury died on September 27, 1956 and is buried in Bathwick Cemetery, Bath. In accordance with her will, her studio and all her records were destroyed.

May Police Update

I hope there will be a time when I won't start off by mentioning Coronavirus. That time seems tantalisingly close. As infection rates continue to fall, the road to recovery appears on track. We will see the imminent re-opening of the hospitality sector, an easing of households meeting indoors and what, seemingly, is a glimpse of the 'old normal'. Rather like a retreating glacier, this virus has scarred our landscape, meaning our behaviours and how we interact with each other has had to adjust. We know that viruses' thrive in the winter period. How we conduct ourselves now will determine the threat we face in the future months. An eye on the rest of the world tells you that the pandemic is far from over. Through regular hand washing, wearing of face masks when required to do so, frequent testing and getting vaccinated, we can secure a better outcome in the future.

A good outcome worthy of mention is our week-long anti knife crime operation. This led to 36 arrests across the force and more than 50 knives being taken off the streets. Your teams carried out a number of knife sweeps, deployed the portable knife arches, conducted proactive patrols and performed a number of stop and search activities where appropriate. The **We Don't Carry #LivesNotKnives** online campaign reached over 350,000 people across digital and social media channels. Tackling Knife crime is not confined to targeted operations but continues as part of our daily business. There is no "respect" or "bravery" in carrying a knife, only cowardice.

I am pleased to report that Sgt Shaun Randall has been awarded the Queen's Commendation for Bravery. Shaun has been policing the West area for over a decade as a PC and more recently as a Sergeant. The Hinckley Road explosion in 2018 remains fresh in the minds of many. Shaun was one of the first on scene in what can only be described as carnage. In a selfless act, and in spite of the marauding fire, he crawled through the rubble to pull a young man to safety.

A particular mention to the selfless work of the Woodgate community Food bank, which has now moved to Rally House on Bonchurch Street. The work they do for the community is simply astounding, and it is great to see this old building being put to good use. We also hold regular beat surgeries there, which are advertised on Neighbourhood link and our West Leicester social media pages (Twitter & Facebook). Pop down and see for yourself the good work that is going on there, and if you have some spare time to give, then get involved. In the interim, keep safe and be a good neighbour

CAREY'S COMPOST CORNER



As soon as May arrives we're itching to plant out our summer bedding. However the climate doesn't always offer the best growing conditions; frost can be forecast even into June.

The safest practice is to keep your carefully selected bedding plants indoors or in a warm greenhouse until at least the end of May. You'll find me running outside with rolls of horticultural fleece trying to protect them as much as possible if there's a frost forecast! Any bedding plants grown indoors or in the greenhouse need to be acclimatised; that means putting them outside on warm days and bringing back in for the cold evening or protecting with fleece. This ensures that plant growth is not stunted.



To produce bushier plants, I like to nip out the growing points. I also remove any flower heads if I'm not ready to plant them out as this conserves the plants' energy. When I'm ready to plant up, I always have water retaining granules at the ready, good quality peat free compost and granular feed. These three items help to retain moisture in the container and provide enough food for the bedding plants for three months.

I have applied a top dressing to my lawns this month; you can do this anytime during the growing season in spring or autumn, but I find it best when a prolonged wet period is on the way. Topdressing helps to improve drainage, promote growth, level lawns and enables repair of patchy or worn areas. I use a mixture of loam based soil and sand, followed by a scattering of grass seed on any bare or thin patches.

In the coming weeks I will earth up my potatoes and protect their top-growth if there is a frost. The frost wont kill the potato plants but can delay flowering and subsequently harvest. I am going to build a support system for my runner beans for when they are finally able to go out. I shall also thin out my carrot seedlings and cover them with a horticultural fleece, this reduces damage by carrot fly. Finally, I am going to keep on top of weeding – I want all the nutrients to go to my plants and not moisture-hogging weeds.
