





Sept Police Update

Your teams continue to be proactive against drug dealing and crime in the area. Police search warrants this month have been completed at: Andrews Close where 3 people were arrested and class A drugs recovered and Fosse Road North where 3 people arrested for burglary;

If you see suspicious activity going on in your area with people regularly visiting and leaving an address then please report anonymously to Crimestoppers via 0800 555 111. This allows us to identify new priorities for police activity in the coming months.

We continue both uniform and plain clothes patrols in the area of Bede Park, Western Boulevard and Western Road with one plain clothes patrol arresting one person on Bede Park for possession with intent to supply class A drugs!

We are also regularly seizing motorbikes being ridden anti-socially in the local area! We have powers to seize bikes in such circumstances but please help us by giving us vehicle registration numbers if possible and ideally the address where bikes are being stored. Please call 101 to report such incidents.

An annual campaign to encourage people across Leicester to consider their safety during the upcoming season of celebrations and events has just been launched.

As part of this year's Celebrate Safely launch, Year 6 pupils from Shaftesbury Junior School, attended Warning Zone, a life-skills centre and children safeguarding charity in Leicester. Here they watched a demonstration by firefighters and were given a tour around Warning Zone.

Tony Huxley's Compost Corner



As summer starts to peter out, I find myself desperately cramming more and more tasks into shorter and shorter days.

My hedge-cutter is working overtime. Those laurel hedges need to be cut before the end of the summer to avoid getting silver leaf fungus. And the Beech and Hornbeam need cutting now so they retain their leaves, like a winter plumage. So, here are a few tips I've learnt over the years about using hedge-cutters.



Always start at the bottom and cut upwards, sweeping the cutter in a gentle arc. Then step

forward, parallel to the hedge and repeat. On a large hedge this can feel like a linear dance. If you cut downwards you can easily pull the hedge out of shape as the weight of the trimmer drags the branches down.

Don't try and go faster than the hedge-trimmer can cut. And don't forget the blades can continue to reciprocate for several seconds after releasing the trigger. It's easy to become complacent, believe me, I have the scars to prove it!

It can be tempting to follow the density of the hedge, cutting harder into thinner areas and going around tougher sections. This will leave the hedge lumpy. Try to just cut in a straight line. Visualize an imaginary line in front of you. If there are hollow sections where you cut nothing off, don't worry, next year it'll have thickened up and it'll look much more even. If there's an area that the hedge-trimmer struggles to cut, come back with a pair of loppers and cut it flush. Step back regularly to check the line of the hedge. If there's a lot of growth, cut it in stages, this is because the hedge shape will change as the weight comes off. Laying a tarpaulin at the base of the hedge will make clearing up afterwards so much easier.

And when you're finished, make sure you oil the trimmer blades before you storing. Last of all, don't forget to admire your handy work with a celebratory cuppa!
