



OVERGROWN WITH POTENTIAL!

Western Park residents are waiting to hear the fate of a 5-acre site on Western Park which has been put up for sale for residential develop-

The freehold to the land, including the Grade II listed Western Park Open School, was offered to bidders and had a closing date of August 5th.

Residents, angry at the sale of the site, which includes the only council owned community buildings in the Western ward, have held several meetings including one with City Mayor, Sir Peter Soulsby, to express their frustration at a process they say has gone ahead without any consultation by local councillors or by the council - and which risks losing valuable green space in a city park.

The meeting heard that local groups and companies have put together proposals for all of the buildings. The Western Park Freeriders would like to use the Eco House, Western Park Beer Festival organisers want a community pub and rooms in the Constance Jackson Centre (Mencap building), Chrysalis Education propose to use the old Environ offices as an education facility for children with complex behavioural needs. Residents had come up, at short notice, with a number of ideas for using the school buildings.

Sir Peter Soulsby promised he would report back to residents in September when he had looked at

any bids that had been submitted. He said they expected any proposals to come in closer to the deadline.

"What you have is my commitment. Before I sign up to anything at all, I would come back and talk to you. Even if we do get something credible we don't have to accept it and I am committing this evening to coming back and talking to you".

"As I understand it, there is no obligation on me to take a bid be-

cause a bid has come in and it's a proposal with credibility. We haven't said this is what it's worth and any bid where that is a credible bid will get it.

"I would just stress I don't want to be discouraging but I have had, over the years, quite a lot of ideas put to me and sometimes they have been made to happen; one such project was the Eco House.

"We have also had others that sounded like realistic proposals and never managed to get the capital together.

"We will need to be sure whatever we do has a realistic prospect to getting the capital together."

CAPABILITY BROWN

Born in 1716, exactly three hundred years ago in Northumberland, Lancelot Brown was to become probably the most famous British landscape architect of all time.

The fifth child of a chambermaid and a land agent, he grew up to become apprenticed as a gardener. He began to show particular flair when working for Lord Cobham at Stow in Buckinghamshire, where his mentor was the well known designer, William Kent.

In his time Lancelot "Capability" Brown went on to design or contribute to some 200 gardens up and down England and Wales including some famous work here in Leicestershire. He gained his nickname because of his habit of stating that he could see considerable "capability" in the various projects he planned to undertake.

Interestingly, whilst his first major work was at Croome Court in Worcestershire, which now in the care of the National Trust, his last great work was here in Leicestershire; the detailed plans for which have only recently been rediscovered.

Brown's work was characterised by sweeping vistas, canalised waterways and often a complete remodelling of the landscape. Readers may have seen some of his most famous work in the gardens of Blenheim Palace, Chatsworth or Burghley near

Stamford. This he latter worked on from 1754 until his death in 1783.

Happily the complete designs for his last great work have recently been rediscovered at Belvoir Castle. (They had been presumed lost in a fire in the 19th century.) Here he planned one of his grandest and most extensive landscapes, tours of which are being widely offered in this his tercentenary year.



We do not know exactly how many gardens Brown worked on in his life. He was not good at keeping records of where he worked but attempts are being made to compile as comprehensive a list as possible of his schemes.

Locally, apart from Belvoir Castle, Stapleford near Melton Mowbray is now a hotel. A deer park had been established around the house in the seventeenth century. Capability Brown was called in to modify and alter the landscape to broadly as we see it today. Combe Abbey just over the Warwickshire border is another of his landscapes.

Brown always fancied himself as an architect but it is his landscapes that have endured over time. His imprint is to be seen today in countless locations up and down the country. **Roger Blackmore**



Hall and a few other places and networking as much as possible".


Mary-Anne chipped in: "We hope to meet a lot of American musicians... And I'm really looking forward to my first trip on the New York subway!"



As highlighted by Sgt Andy Stevens in the last issue of the Gazette, I have returned to Hinckley Road Police Station as the Dedicated Neighbourhood Team (DNT) Sergeant for the Fosse Ward. This covers the area of Fosse Road North and the surrounding sides of Newfoundpool and Tudor Road estate.

Following the boundary changes, it has incorporated the old parts of the Western Park ward, which consisted of the streets bordered by King Richards Road and Glenfield Road. The other side of the old Western Park has been incorporated by the Western Ward DNT under the reign of Sgt Simon Walters.

Regardless of the team, you can still contact the police in an emergency on 999 and in a non -emergency on 101. If you utilise our website at www.leics.police.uk, you'll be able to access all the latest news and details of your Local Policing units.

To update Sgt Stevens, we are still being made aware of incidents of break-ins to vehicles and encourage all drivers to remove valuables from vehicles and not leave anything on show. This will only encourage thieves who may be in the area to target your vehicle. As per our mantra "Leave it on show, expect it to go", we have continued patrolling the areas that have been targeted in order to catch those responsible and it will always help for members of the public who see suspicious activity to call us to report it.

The most significant development to mention is the recent increase in fires at local abandoned factories. There have been incidents on a number of streets throughout the Fosse Ward and the Abbey Ward. We are working with both the Fire Service and the Local City Council in



order to reduce the risk to premises and to assist in the investigation of any incidents we suspect to be deliberate arsons. We have conducted undercover patrols and high visibility patrols to combat this. Anyone with any information with regard to who may be responsible for these fires is encouraged to contact us, as we want to prevent any further fires.

Tony Huxley's Compost Corner

My neighbours purchased a lovely pair of lollipop bay trees the other week. They stood in little faux lead pots either side of their front door, creating extra kerb appeal. Now they look like kindling. If you rubbed the stems together you'd start a fire.

Each summer we waste millions buying expensive outdoor pot plants that won't survive beyond the Autumn. With just a little forethought most of these losses could be avoided. When you buy any pot plant you have to remember it's like having a caged pet, without your intervention it will soon perish.

The smaller the pot, the less water it can hold, so the more it needs watering (obvious really), maybe twice daily in hot weather. Small pots are also more easily blown over. Rain alone is rarely sufficient to water a dried out pot plant, even if they're upright, so don't expect nature to do your dirty work. Generally speaking bigger pots, easier care, longer life.

If the soil has dried out don't rely a quick sprinkling to do the trick. Desiccated soil is hard to probably won't be asking this year. rehydrate. The best method is to submerge the

pot in a large bucket of water until it is thoroughly soaked.

Soil type can make a big difference. I prefer loambased composts (or I add some good quality topsoil). This is heavier than regular potting compost making the plant less likely to topple over. Some composts have special wetting agents. You can also add waterretaining gels or crystals, but some could be potential pollutants as they

don't degrade in the environment.

It's not just heat that increases water demand. Putting the plant in a windy spot will increase transpiration and therefore water loss. Moving the plant to a sheltered spot or giving it a windbreak

If you going away, there are effective timed watering systems that will keep your botanical pets in good health. Personally I find a bottle of plonk is enough enticement to get my neighbours to do the job. Of course there's one set of neighbours I


