#### **DIGGING IT ALL UP!**

Motorists and pedestrians in Westcotes and the Fosse are in for an interesting year as important arterial roads in the area undergo a major transformation.

Work on Braunstone Gate will continue until the middle of March to create a 'Mini Holland" scheme aimed at improving pedestrian safety and comfort by widening pavements and reducing car access, but the biggest road change is to Woodgate.

As part of that project, the city council are overhauling the busy FiveWays junction which links Blackbird Road, Woodgate, Fosse Road North, Groby Road and Buckminster Road.

Work is being carried out in phases to help minimise disruption, and the overall project is expected to be complete by spring 2024.

During the initial phase, part of Blackbird Road and Buckminster Road are closed to through traffic with local diversions in place.

The experimental road closure on Buckminster Road was removed at the start of the FiveWays redevelopment. A review and surveys will be carried out, after the highway works are completed, to fully understand the impact of the new junction on traffic flow on Buckminster Road and the surrounding streets.

A second phase which will involve improvements to

Fosse Road North between the FiveWays junction and Stephenson Drive has started. This involves removing the existing mini roundabout at the junction of Fosse Road North and Stephenson Road and replacing it with a signalised junction; widening the road to help provide a new bus only lane on Fosse Road North on the approach to FiveWays junction. A new cycle track will be created and raised table crossings will be installed across Bonchurch Street and Central Road to improve pedestrian safety. Access to Rally Park will also be improved.

Work on Fosse Road North is expected to take around 14 weeks to finish and is closed to south-bound traffic which now runs in a one-way direction towards the FiveWays junction between Stephenson Drive and the FiveWays junction. Well signed diversions is in place, but some bus services are also affected, with diversions and nearby alternative routes in place.


It's an on-going problem, and one that a local environmental campaigner has been tackling head on over the last few weeks.

Adrian Ablett says he's spent hours picking up rubbish from the Fosse and Westcotes areas: He commented: "Last weekend on Little Holme Street and the Glenfield Road East carpark, I picked up



25 bags of rubbish and 5 bags of recyclables, plus the bigger stuff like mirrors and car tyres, and 39 large nitrous oxide (laughing gas) canisters. Then I call the Cleansing Department who come and pick it all up within a day."

Adrian finds the process soul destroying: "There's no respect for the area. I spend all that time clearing up one road and 24 hours later the rubbish is back. It shocks me to see how much I can find in one little space and how quickly it fills up again."

#### HMO SCHEME EXPANDED

New controls to the number of homes being converted into Houses in Multiple Occupation (HMOs) in West Leicester came into effect on February 17<sup>th</sup>. This followed a public consultation with city residents who raised concerns about parking problems, litter, antisocial behaviour, and noise linked to high numbers of HMOs in support for parking controls their neighbourhoods.

Under current legislation, planning consent is not needed to convert a house into an HMO designed for between three and six people to live in. However, where there is evidence that high numbers of HMOs in a particular area is having a negative impact, councils can introduce an Article 4 Direction, which would mean planning permission is needed for the residents and businesses to change of use.

An Article 4 Direction has already been in place in can be made on whether or not to implement them. several areas of the city, including West Leicester, to control the number of HMOs.

The latest move sees Leicester City Council expanding, and in some cases joining together, those areas to include thousands more houses in zones where high numbers of HMOs exist.

The previous Article 4 Direction covered parts of Leicester's West End and has now been stretched to include Rowley Fields, to Westcotes, Newfoundpool and parts of the Waterside area.

#### WOODGATE PAY TO PARK

Woodgate residents are being asked for their views on a proposed scheme which has been drawn up to tackle the problem of all day commuter parking in the area.

Initial engagement work with showed residents to be brought in. Residents favoured a scheme which would operate 24/7, with short-term parking provided close to shops and businesses. Now detailed proposals have been drawn up for consider, so that a decision

#### Feb Police Update

The increased police presence, that may have been noticed over recent weeks, has been rewarded with over 50 people arrested and 30 charged with drugs offences, this was part of a force wide policing operation. I can promise you that all the police vehicles that were parked at Tesco's on Narborough Road have not been there because of a 'special offer' on doughnuts, they have been proactively targeting and denying criminals the use of the road network.

Locally, we have continued to execute search warrants at premises suspected to be growing cannabis. The production and sale of cannabis generates large amounts of money for criminal organisations. These premises and criminal groups bypass the electricity meter, making the locations inherently dangerous, and can lead to fires breaking out. Suspicious activity can be reported by telephoning 101, visiting the Leicestershire police website or reporting your concerns anonymously to CrimeStoppers.

The local teams have been busy addressing the issues raised to us by the communities we police. We have received numerous complaints regarding inconsiderate parking in and around most Please park considerately as the school sites. 'engage and explain' phase is now mostly completed and offenders could now find themselves subject to £30 fixed penalty notices where they are obstructing the highway (this includes parking on double yellow lines). We are aware that in certain areas customers using local businesses contribute to the problems. We have been working with our partners and local business to educate people but stopping to make a guick purchase will become considerably more expensive.

Complaints have also been received of speeding vehicles around the Glenfield Road area which is being addressed with the Road Safety Partnership and targeted policing operations over the coming months especially with the closure of Fosse Road North at Groby Road.

The patrols completed in relation to the previous rise in burglary offences have worked, the number of offences is decreasing and we will continue with the operation. Where vulnerable premises or people are identified, work with partners to increase security and safety continues.

The bike registry event held in January at the Team HUB on St Oswalds Road was a success. Registering your bike won't stop it being stolen, but it makes it possible for us to identify it as such and return it to you if we come across it.

# CAREY'S COMPOST CORNER

This month I've treated myself and had all of my garden tools professionally sharpened. The price was very reasonable and it's saved me a lot of time, especially with the chainsaw!

l've now been using my newly honed tools to cut back vigorous shrubs such as buddleia and elder to keep them at a reasonable size. I have also pruned my beech hedge; it had become too big and was blocking out a lot of light. It needed to be pruned when there was no risk of frost, but also before the birds started nesting in it usually around March. Keep



in mind that it's an offence to damage or disturb any wild bird nests. I have cut back dogwoods too to ensure good stem colour for next winter. I've also been tidying up hellebores, cutting back the old leaves, especially those with damage or black spot and I've covered the base of the plants with a homemade mulch

I've also been sowing sweet peas and placed them in an area indoors that gives them a lot of light. In addition, I've sown some seeds in propagators, this helps to keep them moist and the soil at the right temperature. The seeds I've used include nigella, zinnia, rudbeckia, and antirrhinums. Sowing this early means that they will mature early, especially with the added heat. Once they have germinated, I will ensure to keep turning the propagators so that the seedlings don't become leggy, as they always grow toward the light.

Turning my compost was a big heavy job, the medium was quite wet, so I added shredded cardboard and paper. Doing this allows opening up and aeration to take place. If it was too dry I would add more kitchen waste to the bin such as vegetable peelings and occasionally some rainwater.



And finally, I've added a few splashes of colour to the

garden by planting little pots of tete a tete, violas, bellis and primulas.

As spring nears and thirsty/hungry hedgehogs come out of hibernation, don't forget to leave out a dish of fresh water and cat food! *Carey Tunstall*
