THE LORD LIEUTENANT

Office of Lord Lieutenant dates back to the reign of Henry 8th when the king decided to appoint an individual in each county as the personal representative of the monarch. This

summer, Leicester's latest Lord Lieutenant, Lady Gretton, who is now 75, leaves office after over fifteen years in the job. Her predecessor was Sir Tim Brookes of Wistow.

One of the key functions of the post traditionally was to raise the County militia. This role became increasingly important as



England saw the growing threat of a Spanish invasion. This culminated in the appearance of the Spanish Armada by which time a Lord Lieutenant was in post for every English county

Oliver Cromwell did away with the post in the aftermath of the Civil War but Charles 2nd brought it back and the appointment of Lords Lieutenant has continued ever since

Today the Lord Lieutenant has a key role in the arrangements for Royal Visits to the County and in

escorting Royal visitors. He or she also presents a variety of awards and medals on behalf of the Queen in addition to carrying out a wide variety of engagements. These relate to military groups and a whole range of voluntary and community organisations within the city and county.

The post is unpaid and non-political and the post holder can also appoint a plethora of deputies to assist with their work. One of Lady Gretton's appointed deputies is none other than the BBC Radio Leicester broadcaster, Dave Andrews.

Lady Gretton comes from the Stapleford area, near Melton Mowbray. She has been President of Loros since 1999. She is also patron of a whole range of local organisations including the Leicester Early Music Society. She chose to mark her retirement with a gigantic "knees up" at Curve in June.



She is succeeded by Mike

Kapur OBE, a local entrepreneur, who is the Chairman of the National Space Centre, Leicester City Football Club Trust and Pro Chancellor of De Montfort University.

A BIG THANK YOU TO AUSTIN

It's not every day a seven-year-old youngster gets to ride in a police car with blue lights flashing. But then Austin Ayling from Western Park is no ordinary boy.

As soon as he heard about the disaster in Hinckley Road in February which killed five people, he knew he wanted to help those officers out on the streets working hard to bring the scene under control in tough conditions.

Austin decided the best way he could do this was to provide them with food so he baked some fairy cakes and took them out for them to eat.

As a thank you to Austin, officers arranged for him to visit them at Leicestershire Police' Headquarters alongside his mum, Vicky, and dad Jos.

Austin was greeted by Assistant Chief Constable, Jason Masters, who presented him with a special certificate as a thank you for his efforts to help on that day.

He was then whisked around the site in Enderby for a special tour, including a peak at the Tactical Support Team's base to see the training they undergo and the equipment they use.



In addition, he got to wear some police uniform complete with officers hat, and was given a 'goodie bag' of items including fluorescent stickers for his bike, torch and light up pen. He also got to speak to officers from the road policing team along with call handlers over the police radio.

Austin said: "It was really exciting to be asked to visit. I'd never been in a police car before."

Mum Vicky added: "Austin regularly visits the Menphys charity shop on the same road as the disaster so when he found out what had happened he genuinely just wanted to help and baking the cakes was his way of doing that."

Sergeant Jordan Robson, from Tactical Road Policing at Force Headquarters, was responsible for whisking Austin around the site on the day.

He said: "Officers were working in extremely difficult conditions for many hours on the day of the explosion. They were incredibly grateful to Austin for such a lovely gesture and to other members of the public who brought out cups of hot tea and coffee, along with other refreshments".





BLAZE AT BUTCHERS

A man crawled out of a third floor window to escape a blaze which tore through a butchers and flat in Westcotes.

Narborough Road was closed for five hours, during the early evening of July 5th, as eight fire crews tackled the blaze at Sharazun Butchers near the corner of Gaul Street.

There was a heavy police presence as hundreds of people gathered to watch.

Onlookers spotted smoke billowing from the building and dialled the emergency services. The fire effected the butchers and the first floor.

A 32 year old man from Rumania escaped through a window after his exit was blocked by smoke.

An investigation into the cause of the fire began on Friday 6th July. A police spokesman said: "Inquires into the circumstances surrounding the fire are in the early stages".

Forensic teams were also spotted next door, at the Platinum Tanning Studio.




