Maybe I could go to Stonehenge for the summer solstice? It's a long way... it gets very busy... and the toilets are a bit grim. I'm not sure I can be bothered... I wonder... #### THE GREAT NEW YEAR FLY TIP

A year ago West Leicester was one of the worst fly tipping areas in the city and it seems little has changed over the last 12 months.

The last figures (Up to Nov 18) revealed that there were 2980 instances of illegal fly tipping in Western Park, Westcotes and the Fosse neighbourhoods.

A New Year walk around the area, uncovered a huge amount of waste left dumped on street corners creating an on-going headache for the City Wardens and the Cleansing Dept.



Areas, like parts of Westcotes and the Fosse, with high density rented housing and low car ownership tend to be the worst effected in spite of council interventions to make residents aware of their responsibilities.

Across the UK fly tipping has reached a 10 year high and £50 fines are failing to deter offenders said the Local Government Association.

# All Hale The Ale 2020

Western Park's pop-up pub will be returning to St Anne's Church Hall on Friday 20 March.

The popular event - featuring ale, cider, wine, soft drinks and snacks - will raise funds for the annual charity beer festival on the 18 and 19 September.

Selina Conroy, Chairman of Western Park Beer Festival, said: "After last September's event we were able to donate an incredible £12,000 to local charities.

"This means we have, with the continuing support of locals, raised £52,000 for good causes since we started pouring pints five years ago.

"People attending our popular pop-up in March can once again expect the usual good quality beer, great company and a short walk home."

The 2019 festival supported Leicester Wheels For All, Leicester Home-Start Horizons and Project Hive. Sadly, the plan to support Coram's East Midlands adoption agency in Shepshed failed when head office announced it was shutting the branch.

The PUP runs from 5pm to midnight and is for over 18s only.

#### **5 FACES OF SECULARISM**

The most striking Victorian building in Humberstone Gate is undoubtedly the Secular Hall.

Secular Society had been founded in the nineteenth century by Josiah Gimson and others. They soon took up the idea of establishing a base for the society somewhere in the City Centre. Gimson, founder of the huge Vulcan Engineering works and a member of a famous Leicester family, was a significant public figure and prominent free-thinker. He was elected a city councillor for the St Mary's ward (Around St Mary de Castro Church) and in time served as Mayor. Having identified a site for the proposed new Secular Hall in Humberstone Gate, he set to work, with the designer Larner Sugden, from Leek in Staffordshire, on the building we see today. He also donated significant funds to the new project.


The Secular Hall was opened in 1881in the presence of, amongst others, no less a figure than George Bernard Shaw. Throughout its long history it has acted as host to many famous people. In 1884 William Morris, of the Arts and Crafts Movement, gave a talk on Art and Socialism, while a hundred years later, some of us remember going there to hear Michael Foot, the Labour politician, who on that occasion sported a very smart suit, thus contradicting the comments often made about his outfits. Josiah's elder son, Sydney, went on to become

President of the Secular Society having always been a very enthusiastic member. In this, he was unlike his younger brother Ernest, the architect, who moved away and became a significant figure in the Arts and Crafts movement



An interesting, and, at the time, controversial, feature of the building are the five busts on the outside. They are of Jesus, Voltaire, Tom Paine, Socrates and Robert Owen and the equality of status accorded to Jesus with the other figures provoked a considerable hostile reaction.



# Jan Police Update

Leicestershire Police is thanking the public after 500 fewer calls were made to the force over the festive period in comparison with last year.

On 24, 25, 26, 31 December and 1 January, the force received a total of 5,120 calls to 999 and 101 compared to a total of 5,620 calls to 999 and 101 for the same dates last year.

Superintendent Grant Wills, Head of Contact Management Department said: "It is very welcoming to see such a reduction on last year's figures and I would like to thank the public for only calling us in a genuine emergency or for police assistance.

"Despite 500 fewer calls, Christmas and New Year still puts a significant amount of demand on the department and I would like to thank all those involved in working hard to deliver this service to the public."

Chief Constable Simon Cole said: "New Year was particularly busy for us with 243 emergency 999 calls received between midnight and 3am.

"This resulted in a huge team effort by colleagues to answer and deal with these calls and action where police attendance was needed.

"2019 has been a demanding year for the force but I am extremely pleased that we were able to start 2020 on this note."

# Tony Huxley's Compost Corner

Hurrah! You've survived Christmas.

By now the decorations are all stowed away, ready for next year. But if your home was adorned with one of the seven million real Christmas trees where is it now? Is it sitting in a neglected corner of the garden while you try to forget about it? Conifer wood is very resinous so decomposes very slowly. During a recent garden makeover, I discovered the skeletal remains of 5 previous trees, lined up like ghosts of Christmas past.

I could have stripped the leaves off and used the trees as stakes for beans or flowers to grow along or spread the needles across a muddy path to make it less slippery or even used the branches as part of frost protection measures over delicate flower beds... I did none of those.

The best thing is to recycle your tree. It can be cut up and put in with the green waste, assuming you're not on one of those council schemes that stops during the winter months, because who needs to dispose of garden waste during the main pruning season? Your local recycling centre will gladly accept your old tree, where it will be chipped and turned into compost. Only 10% of

Christmas trees get recycled. Many end up going to landfill where the average tree will release 16kg of CO<sub>2</sub> into the atmosphere, so do make the effort to dispose of it responsibly.

Some believe a tree isn't just for Christmas, it may even stretch to a second outing! Potted

Christmas trees rarely make it through a month in a centrally heated house unscathed. Many recover. Some are bare root plants that are lifted and potted up just before Christmas and have had their roots trimmed. Congrown specimens tainer tend to fare better. If you have a potted tree, make sure it's put outside as soon as possible. Plant it



into a bigger pot and water well, especially in the warmer months, but don't leave it standing in water. You could plant it out for a year and lift it next December. Or you may be planning to plant it out permanently. But beware. If I had a pound for every time the owner of a "free-range" Xmas tree has told me "I never knew it would get this big!" I'd have paid for next Christmas already!


